

Cornerstone Awana Bring a Friend Options

The intent of the bring-a-friend sections is to give acquaintances the opportunity to hear the gospel message. Alternative activities that accomplish the same purpose can be substituted. Here are some ideas to consider from Awana headquarters. The leadership from each church discusses and selects the option(s) that works best for their situation.

- * Do an outreach project such as going to a nursing home to visit, sending cards to the residents, or preparing a meal for someone in who is in need.

- * Write a letter to a friend explaining what Awana is; give a simple salvation message and an invitation to club. Your leader should read the letter and send it to the friend.

- * Bring two friends to your church Christmas or Easter program.

- * Wear your Awana uniform in public. List the dates and places.

- * Hand out 5 fliers inviting visitors to a special Awana night. Parents sign a form to confirm their child completed the assignment.

- * Invite 3 friends to Awana. If they can't come, write their names down in your book with a notation that they couldn't come. Parent's initials on the section will confirm completion of assignment.

- * Fill out and address two Awana invitation post cards, (ask your leader for them,) and bring them in for your leader to read and send.
