About Awana Quiz

Clubbers who reach a particular goal in their handbooks during the first half of the club year are offered the opportunity to join a quiz team. This team meets with quiz teams from other Awana churches to test their mastery of the materials in their handbooks. There are a few practices preceding the actual Quiz event. These are for the purpose of familiarizing the clubber with the rules and methods used at the meet. They get to become comfortable with the format and hear sample quiz questions. Clubbers wear their club uniform to this event. Clubber's parents are encouraged to attend!! Quizzers earn individual medals for their team's placement, one plaque for the team for 1st place, (kept at church,) and all participants get a patch for their uniform.

How to Qualify for Quiz

Be an Awana clubber in T&T Books 1, 2, 3 or 4 who has completed at least the first four Discoveries or Challenges by January 23rd. The clubber can quiz in one of the books that he has not quizzed in before, but should quiz in the most current book that he/she meets the qualifications in. Clubbers will be quizzed **only on the first four Discoveries or Challenges and the Start Zone**. Cornerstone teams are comprised of clubbers quizzing in the same book.

Preparation for Quiz

There will be 3 practices in preparation for Quiz. Coaches and Clubbers will meet for 1.5 hours on four Saturday's starting on January 23rd. The first practice is mandatory for first time quizzers. All Clubbers must attend at least two practices in order to participate. We prefer they come to all of them, but realize sports or other commitments may prevent that. (Contact Fran Simmler, Cornerstone Quiz director, for any special circumstances.) The schedule is as follows:

Practice: Saturday, January 23rd, 9:30-11:00am

Practice: Saturday, January 30th, 9:30-11:00am

Practice: Saturday, February 6th, 9:30-11:00am

Quiz: Saturday, February 13th, 1:00-4:00 (approximate time)

Questions will come from the Start Zone and the first 4 Discoveries/Challenges of the applicable book. Clubbers will be able to answer questions in the version that they are using in club, KJV, NKJV, or NIV.

Dress Code for Quiz Day

Awana emphasizes the importance of modesty, neatness and cleanliness in the apparel worn by both leaders and clubbers of all ages. All Cornerstone participants (including leaders and coaches) must wear an official Awana uniform." Boys should think Sunday pants, and nicer shoes. Girls will wear a dress or skirt with the hem falling below the knees **when sitting**, and nicer shoes.

Quiz Day

Quizzers will sit with their coach and their team during quiz. The day starts with Book 4 and works backwards through the afternoon. Family and friends are all invited to attend. Two rooms will be available downstairs for parents to watch quiz with children who cannot sit the whole time upstairs.

At Quiz we will be providing two rooms downstairs for family members to use for watching their other children who cannot sit the whole time in the sanctuary during Quiz. Cornerstone has two rooms which are set up with large screen TVs that on Sunday's broadcast the sermon. We will use these rooms for broadcasting Quiz. One room is a quiet room for Mom's who need a quiet place for themselves and their babies. The other room is larger and will be for toddlers and one or more of their parents to go to. Again, you **WILL** be able to watch Quiz from these rooms while at the same time tending to your younger tykes. There will be no manned nursery.
